Seminole County Codes Chapter 20, Ordinances Pertaining to Animals

Section 20.18 Urinating and Defecating

It shall be unlawful for any animal owner to permit, either willfully or through failure to exercise due care and control, any animal to soil, defile, urinate or defecate on any private or public property, other than that of the owner, without expressed or implied consent.

The fine for violating this ordinance is \$50.00

Let's work together to resolve this issue. Please be considerate and clean up after your dogs. Cleaning up after your dogs shows respect for others in our community and your actions set an example for others. When you pick up after your dog you are part of the solution rather than part of the problem.
